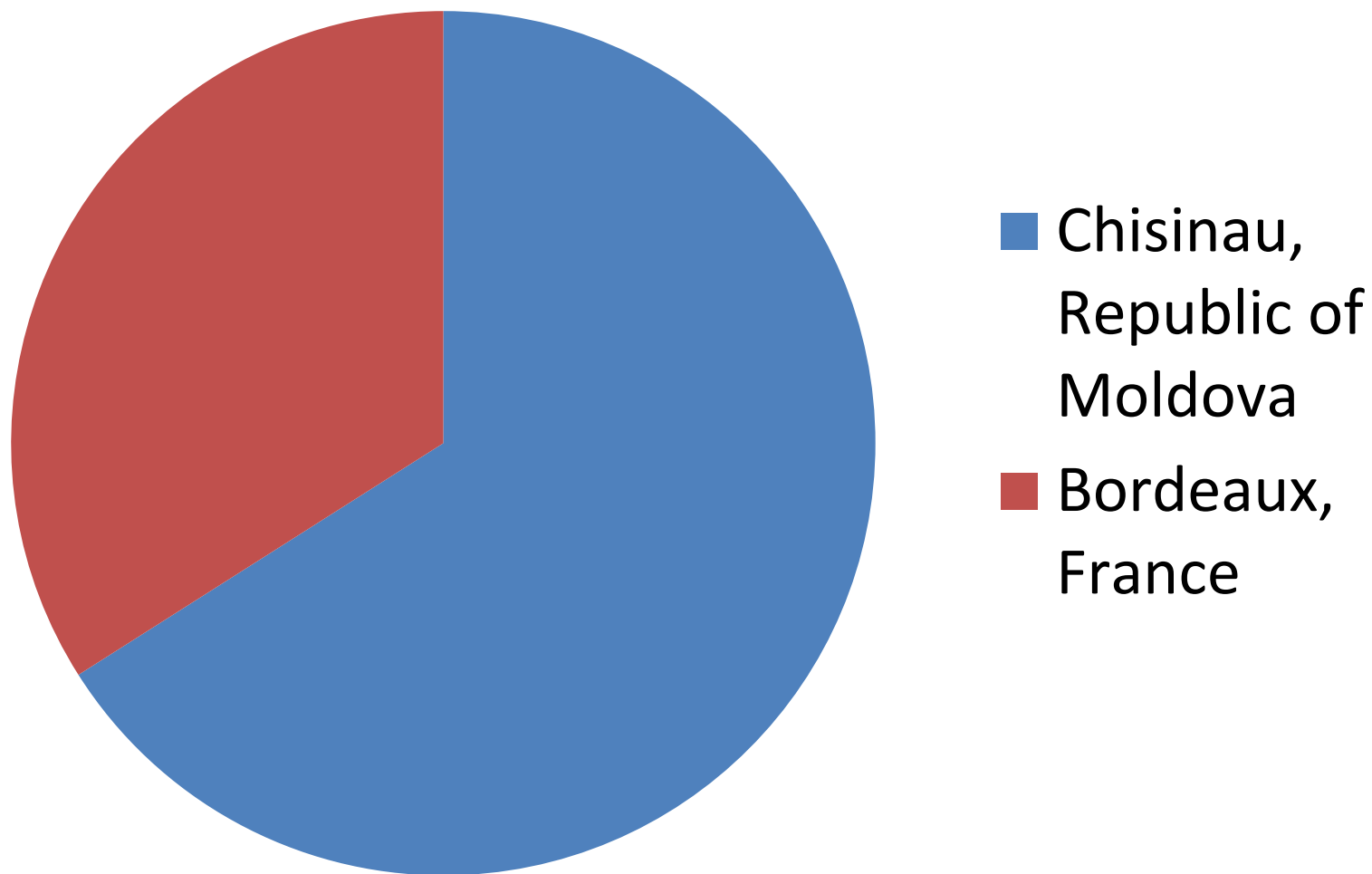

- Strong Union of Walnut Growers' Association



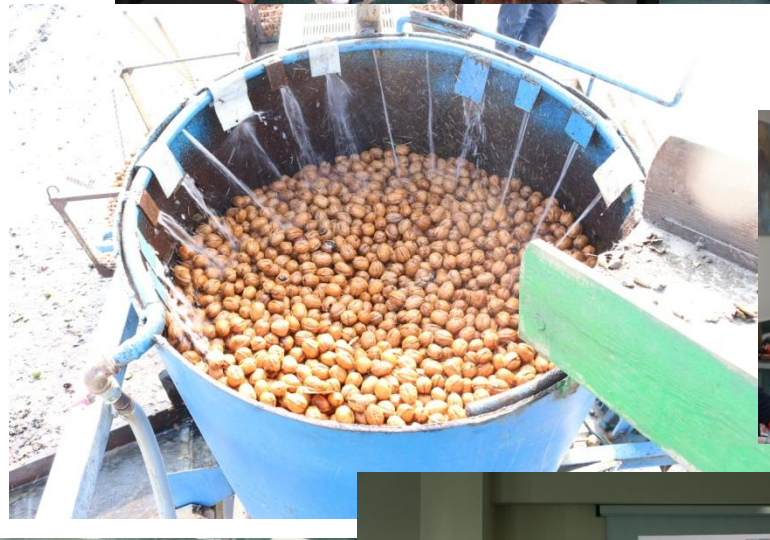
